A Dog's Tail: Dog Bite Prevention Week Tip

Did you know that it can mean different things when a dog's tail is wagging? A wagging tail can mean anything from the dog is very happy to the dog is very afraid. Here are what a few different types of tail wags can tell us about what the dog is feeling and communicating to us:

CALM WAG: A tail wagging loosely below the level of the dog's back. When accompanied by a smiling dog (relaxed, open mouth), the dog may be ready to interact and greet.

WARNING WAG: A tail that is held high and wagging stiffly. This dog would like for you to please back off.

VERY HAPPY / EXCITED WAG: A tail that is moving while the whole body wags. Adults may want to keep children back from greeting until the dog is a little less excited.

UNCERTAIN / ASSESSING WAG: A tail that is wagging very slowly, generally accompanied by a stiff body. The dog is not ready to greet you. He is deciding.

VERY HAPPY WAG: A tail that is circling around like a helicopter's propeller. Dogs who are wagging their tail like a propeller are usually wagging for somebody very special.

All adoptable cats have been spayed or neutered, are up to date on their rabies and distemper shots, have been tested for feline AIDS and leukemia, and are microchipped. They also come with 30 days pet health insurance coverage.

The Carroll County Animal Shelter is not owned or operated by CCHS, but we are active in encouraging the adoption of shelter animals through our volunteer work at the shelter and at off-site events. We are hopeful that the reduced rates will encourage people to adopt and help these deserving cats and kittens find their forever homes.

If you would like to donate dry dog/cat food, you can drop it off at any of our drop-off locations: Horton's, St. Margarets, Carroll County Animal Hospital, and Carroll County Animal Shelter.

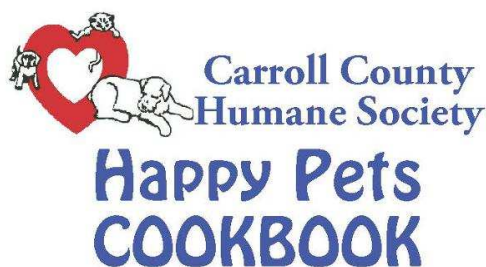

SCARED / UNCERTAIN WAG: A tail that is wagging very low or tucked. This dog is probably very afraid and would prefer to be left alone.

Please note that these are general tips about tail wags. Tail wags can look different for dogs with docked tails or dogs with tails that naturally curve up and over a dog's back. Children and adults should always ask permission before greeting or petting a new dog.
