# How to Provide a Fun and Stimulating Environment for Your Dog

Dogs who are provided with fun and stimulating activities will be happier and more well adjusted, generally experiencing fewer behavior problems.

Do you work all day? There is still a lot you can do to help keep your dog entertained, even when you're not there. Here are a few of my favorite ways to keep dogs busy and happy:

- Rather than feed your dog breakfast out of a bowl, put the food in a toy, such as a KONG Wobbler or other food puzzle toy. This will keep your dog busy working for his food instead of just gobbling food out of a bowl within seconds.
- Stuff a KONG with a yummy treat filling, freeze it for 30 minutes, and then hide it somewhere in your dog's area for him to find later. Make the hiding spot easy for the first few days to get your dog interested in searching. (The CCHS Happy Pets Cookbook has a whole section of recipes for KONG fillings! For more information on how to purchase a copy of our cookbook, go to the Announcements section on the CCHS website.)
- If your dog really likes to sniff, you can hide small piles of food around the yard for your dog to find throughout the day. This is a great way to entertain the dog who likes to spend time outside during the day. It can also help reduce barking and digging behaviors caused by boredom.

Here are a few games and enrichment activities to engage in with your dog while you are home:

- Hide & Seek: Start off by hiding just around the corner from your dog. Call your dog's name and when he finds you, tell him what a smart dog he is and give him a piece of kibble or treat as a reward.
- Fetch: You can incorporate some obedience practice into your game. Before you throw the toy, ask your dog to sit, lay down, or target/touch your hand with his nose. As soon as your dog responds to the request, say "good boy" and throw the fetch toy as a reward.
- Spend time slowly and gently petting your dog or rubbing his belly. Soft, gentle touches while you quietly talk to your dog are a great way to provide relaxation for both of you.

As always, have fun training and playing with your dod!
